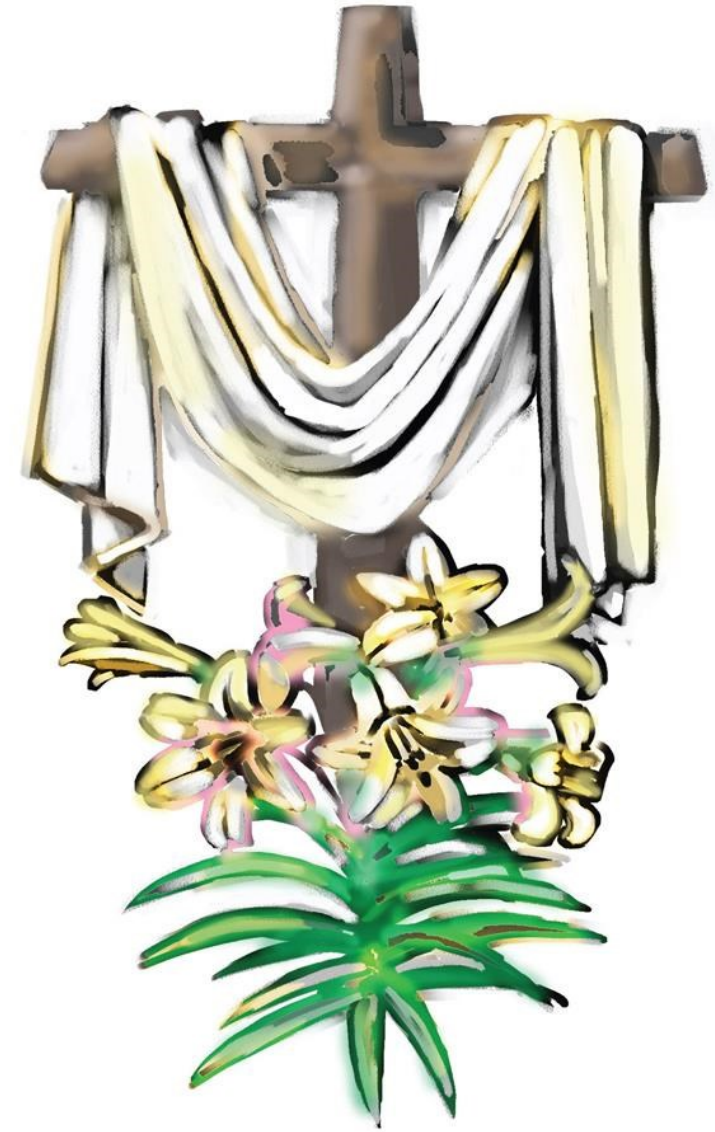

*Christianity and World Religions*

Starting the Sunday after Easter and running for 5 consecutive weeks, April 23-May 21, a video series by Adam Hamilton will be offered Sunday mornings at 10:00 AM in Room 111 facilitated by Travis Williamson. This class is open to all adults and youth.
