### **Buckhorn Children and Family Services**

Boulevard has supported Buckhorn several times over the years, and the quilters continue to provide quilts for their beds. Buckhorn has reached out to Boulevard asking for our help. When the floods hit Eastern Kentucky, Buckhorn sustained a great deal of damage. Even now that the waters have receded, the road to the homes has been washed out, so employees and volunteers must walk in to serve the people. Their mission is to serve kids and strengthen families as they work to overcome a variety of life crises, including chronic and severe abuse and neglect. With the 2022 mission budget already accounted for, the Board of Deacons decided to help. The Board of Deacons will match the first \$1,000 given by the congregation.
